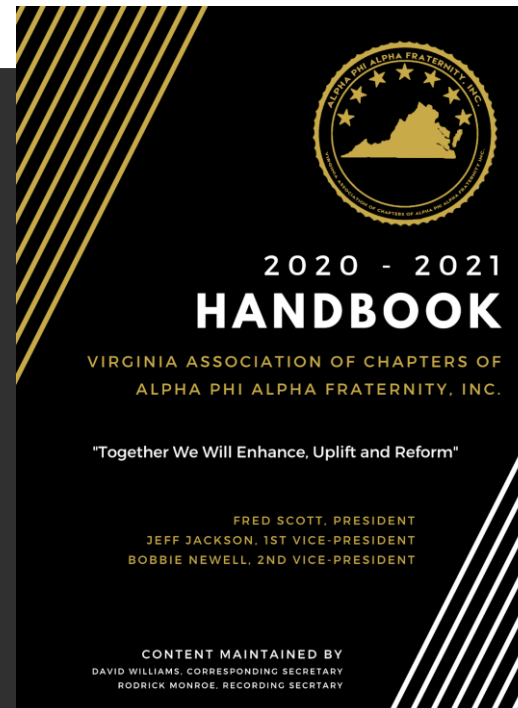
Goals & Activities Accomplished This Term

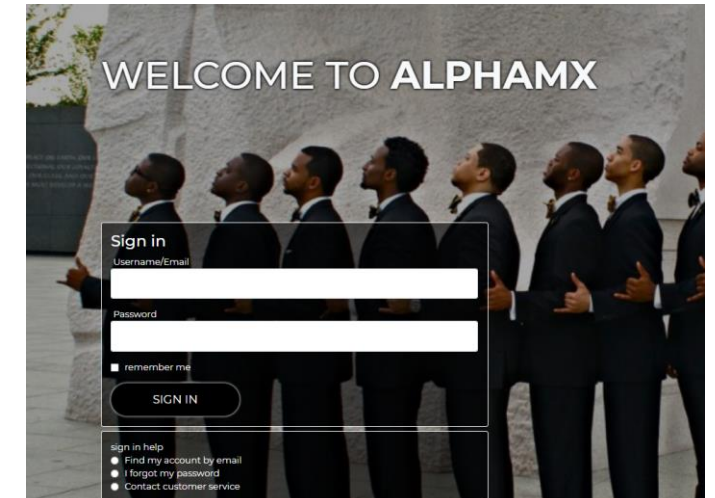
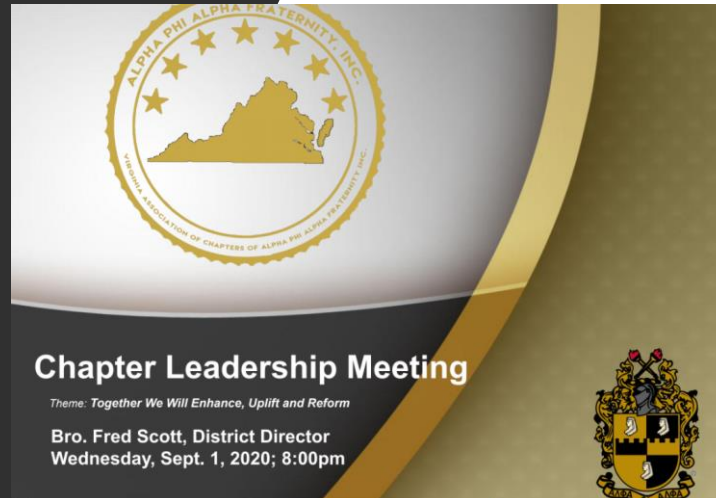


Operations Management

- **100%** of the chapters used AlphaMX to update directories and officers, manage chapter membership, and use a tool to monitor reclamation.

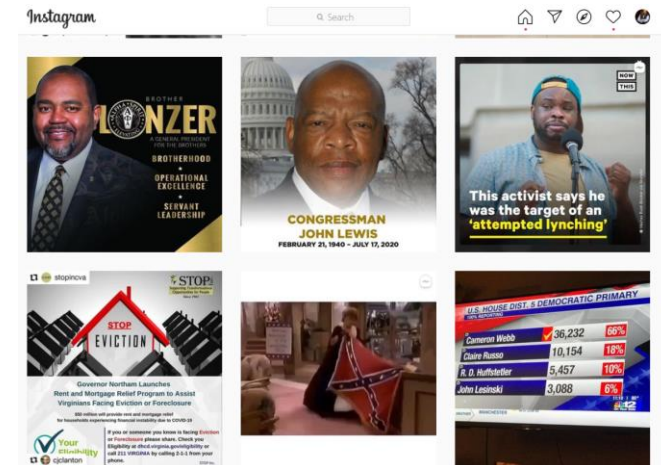
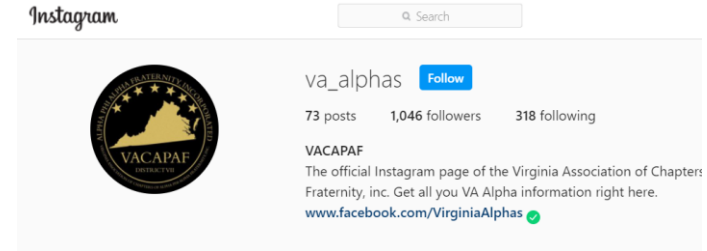
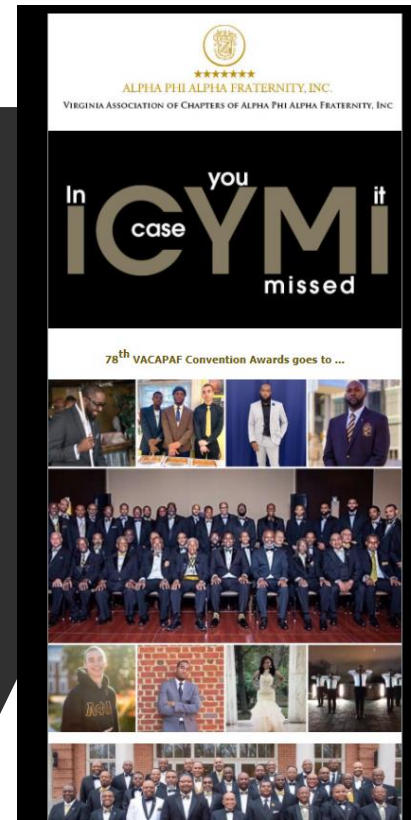

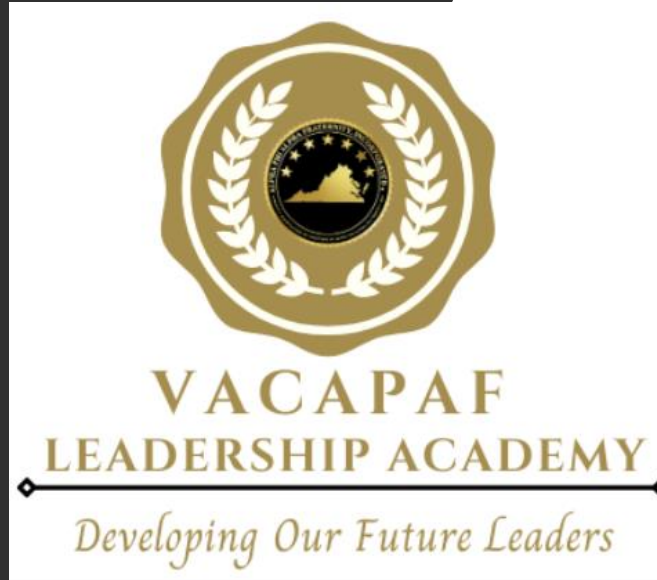
Communications/Brand Management Management

- Chapters and district promote through social media programs, projects, district successes, social justice, politics, and more.



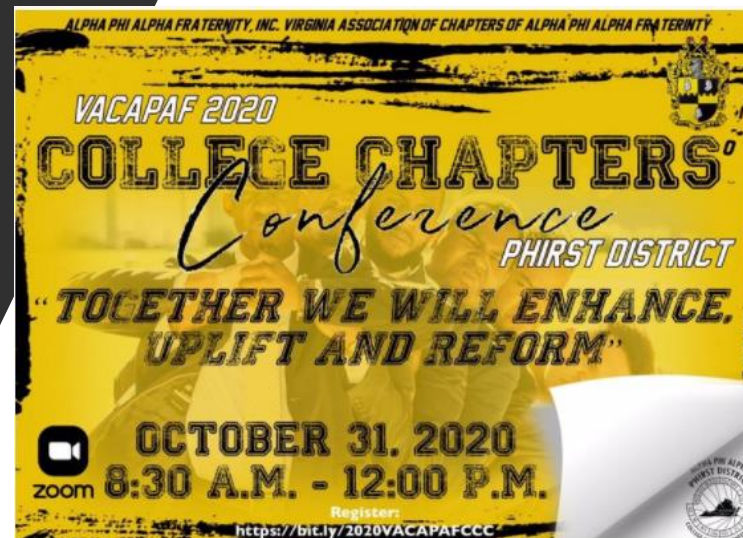
Leadership/Membership Management

- The brotherhood engagement and commission teams targeted a reclamation effort of 10% increase. The district's actual results were **225%** beyond the goal.
- The trained **637** brothers in IMDP.
- The district provided **6 Office Hour Sessions** with the AlphaMX trainer.
- The district kicked off the **Leadership Academy** with the first group/class of brothers.
- **100%** of the college brothers participated in the College Chapters' Conference.

Fiscal Management

- The district implemented its' first completely virtual conference with **297 registered attendees** with 100% profit.
- The district voted to assess only the alumni chapters. **100%** of the chapters paid their assessments. Addend the by-laws to adjust assessments for college chapters due the COVID-19 crisis.
- The district started with a **zero-based budget** for the 2020-2021 fraternal year. The district is a 501©7.



Program Management

- The Education Foundation revise the constitution and by-laws for the **VACAPAF Education Foundation**. The name is now **Castle of Dreams** with an endowment of \$85,000.
- The district participated and produced **4 webinars or townhall productions** on advocacy topics.
- The district sponsored a brotherhood engagement activity for new and reclaim brothers called “Alpha Light: Burning Light.”

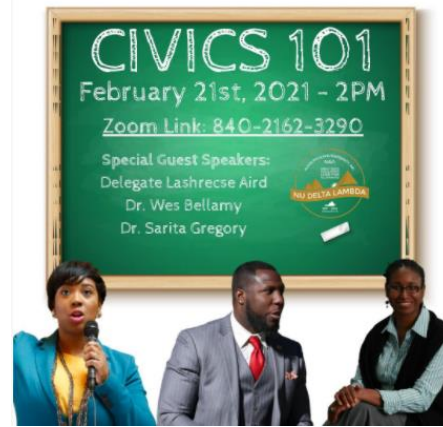


